STARTING THE APPLICATION

To start the application click on the GreenFinder logo.

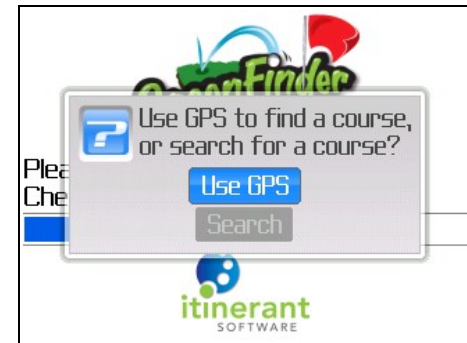


When GreenFinder starts it will check the network functionality to ensure a connection to the service is available. During this time the software will also check if a newer version is available and confirm that you are permitted to use the service.



FINDING A COURSE

The software will then ask if you would like to find a nearby course using GPS or search for a course.



USING GPS

If you choose the GPS option the software will try to acquire your position from the GPS satellites. GPS will only work if you are outdoors. It can take up to 90 seconds to acquire the initial GPS signal and your location. Once your location has been determined the software will contact the service and request a list of marked courses within a 30km radius of your current position.



SEARCHING

If you choose the Search option, you will be presented with a search form. On the form you can enter the information you would like to search for. You can search by course name, city, province or any combination of the three. Once you have entered your search information click the trackball and choose *Search*. The software will then retrieve a list of courses matching your search criteria.

DOWNLOADING A COURSE

If you chose the GPS option, the courses will be listed in order of distance from you, where the first entry is the closest. If you searched for a course, the list will be in alphabetical order. From the *Course Selection* screen you can choose a course you would like to play. Scroll the trackball to highlight your desired course, press the trackball and choose *Play Course*.

PLAYING A COURSE

After a course has been selected, the software will download the course details including the position of the greens and hazards. On the Play screen you will see the distance to the Back, Center and Front of the green of the current hole. You are now ready to play the course using GreenFinder.

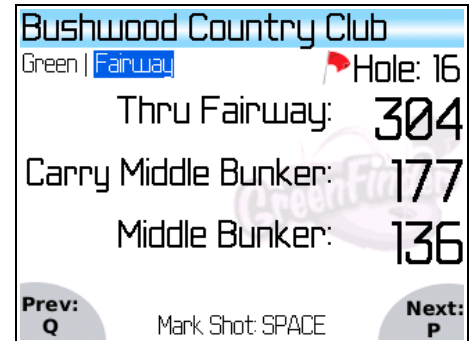

FAIRWAY HAZARDS

On the Play screen you can move the trackball to the right to switch to the *Fairway* view. On the *Fairway* view you will see any fairway hazards that have been marked.



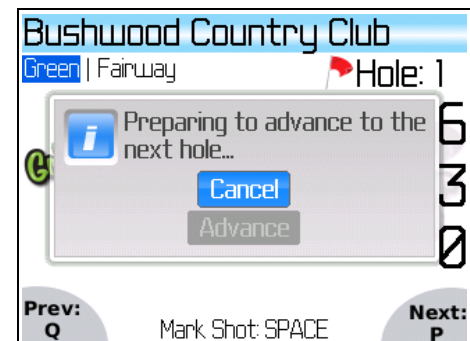
SHOT LENGTH

Pressing the *SPACE* key records where you took a shot from. As you approach your ball the length of the shot is displayed at the bottom of the screen.



AUTO-ADVANCE HOLES

Once you get within 20 yards of the green the software will prepare to auto-advance to the next hole. Once you leave the green the software will automatically advance. You can override this behaviour by selecting *Cancel*. This way the software will show the hole you are playing even if you don't use GreenFinder for a few holes.

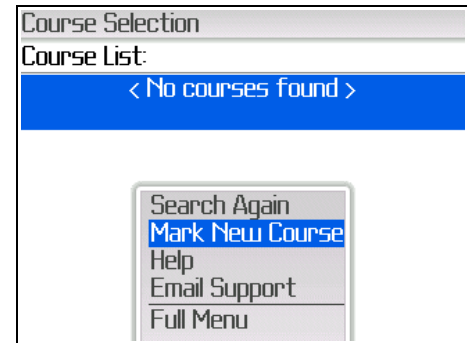


SPEAKS THE DISTANCE

Pressing the *Mute* button on the top of the device causes the device to speak the distance to the center of the green. This way you can easily know the distance without having to look at the screen.

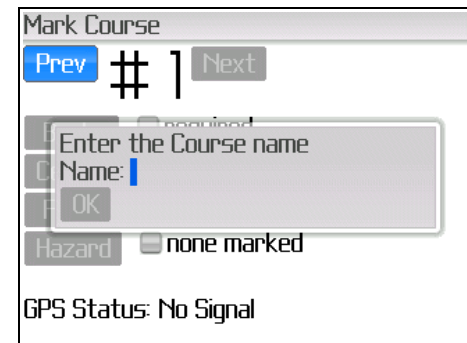
MARKING A NEW COURSE

To mark a new course, first use GPS or search for the course to ensure it hasn't already been marked. From the *Course Selection* screen, press the trackball and choose *Mark New Course*.



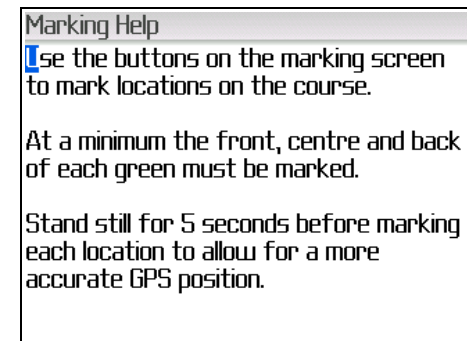
ENTER COURSE NAME

The application will then ask you to enter the name of the new course. Enter the name of the course and press the *OK* button.



HELP SCREEN

The help screen will then display a brief set of instructions. At a minimum, the front, center and back of each green must be marked. Stand still for 5 seconds before marking each location to allow for a more accurate GPS reading. Press the trackball and select *Close* to exit this screen.



WAIT FOR GPS

Wait until the *GPS Status* at the bottom of the screen changes from *No Signal* to *Working*, and then begin marking the locations.



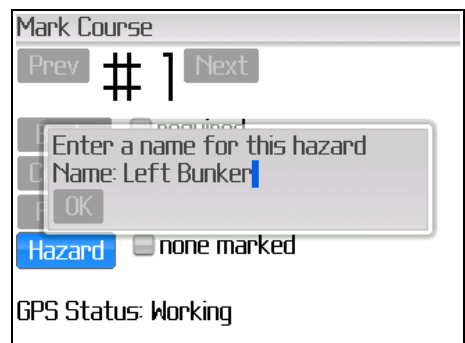
MARK LOCATIONS

To mark a location, simply press the button that corresponds to the location being marked. After the location has been marked and uploaded to the service, you will be notified. Continue marking each location. Use the *Prev* and *Next* buttons to change the hole currently being marked.



MARKING A HAZARD

When marking a Hazard, the software will ask you for a name of the hazard. After entering the name, press OK to upload the location. Try to use a short but descriptive name such as: Left Bunker, Carry Left Bunker, Right Water, Thru Fairway, etc.



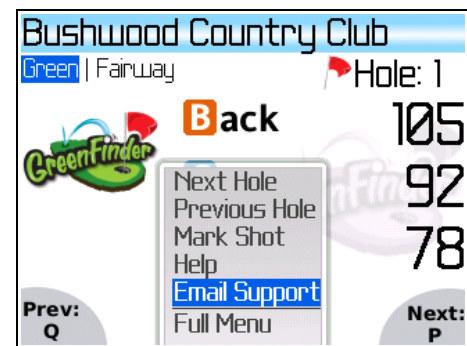
FINISHING MARKING

Once you have marked all of the holes, press the *Menu* key (to the left of the trackball) and choose *Close*. A confirmation dialog box will appear to make sure you want to finish marking the course. The course is automatically uploaded as you mark it. Once it has been reviewed by a member of the GreenFinder team it will be available for use by you and all other GreenFinder users.

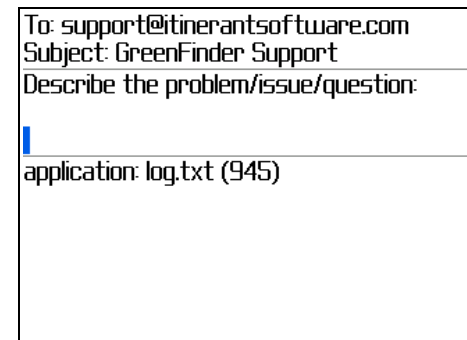


EMAIL SUPPORT

From most screens you have the ability to send an email to support. If you have a question, problem or even a suggestion you can choose the *Email Support* option from the menu.



A new email to support@itinerantsoftware.com will be launched. In this email you can describe your question, problem or suggestion. Once finished typing your message, press the trackball and select *Send*.



SEND TO A FRIEND

If you would like to share GreenFinder with another BlackBerry® user, go to the *Home* screen and choose *Send to a Friend* from the menu.



This will open an email with a quick description of GreenFinder and where your friend can download the application. Enter your friends' email address into the *To:* line of the email. When finished, press the trackball and choose *Send*.
